Office of China Affairs

The University of Maryland has a long and productive relationship with China that dates back to 1915. Since then, UMD has been instrumental in advancing productive U.S.-China relations, including hosting year-round events. These events not only played a national role, but they also laid the foundation for the university to be at the forefront of U.S. higher education's developing relationship with China. In 1996, UMD became one of the first universities to provide training programs for Chinese government officials, training approximately 600 Chinese officials and university administrators every year.

Graduate Legal Aid Office (GLAO)

GLAO is funded by graduate student fees. It provides free legal information, consultations, referrals, and brief assistance to UMCP graduate students on a wide range of both off-campus and university matters. Please note: GLAO does not represent students against the university and cannot advise one student directly against another student in a civil law matter.
